The 2006 property tax administrative appeal deadlines are fast approaching. For Michigan, the deadlines are: Feb 15 for Detroit & Grand Rapids; Feb. 21 for Wyandotte; March deadlines vary for the rest of the State. Through the firm's American Property Tax Counsel membership, it has local counsel to assist with appeals in the rest of the country, where the deadlines generally run between now and the end of May. Making sure administrative appeals are timely filed is critical to obtaining relief. Timely filing the administrative appeal can be as important for one who is a party in interest with respect to a distressed property, even if others hold title to the property.
