Last Thursday, Michigan House Bill 5766 became Public Act 88 of 2020, and August 31 became the State's new property tax appeal deadline for the 2020 tax year.

Honigman convincingly argued that without the extension of the filing deadline, due to the pandemic and government office closures, taxpayers were being deprived of fundamental fairness and due process. Legislators agreed. The bill passed unanimously in both the Michigan House and the Michigan Senate, and it was signed into law by the Governor on June 11, 2020.
